



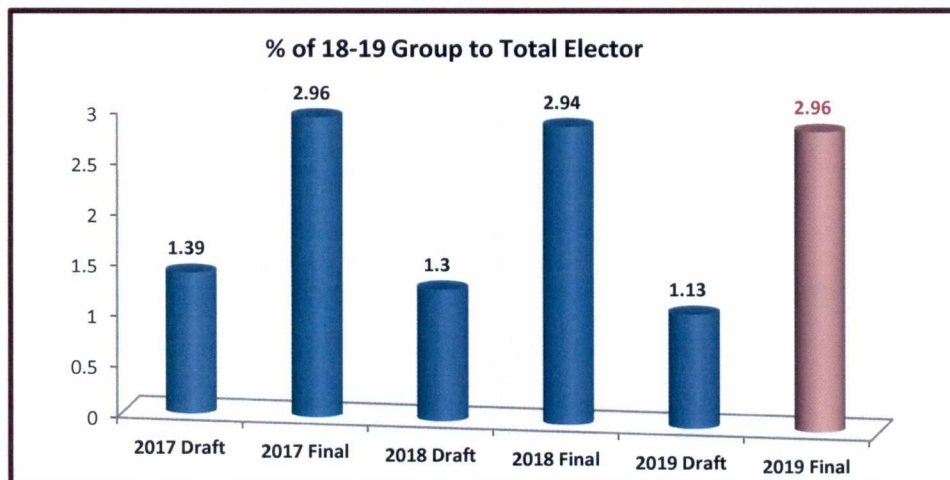
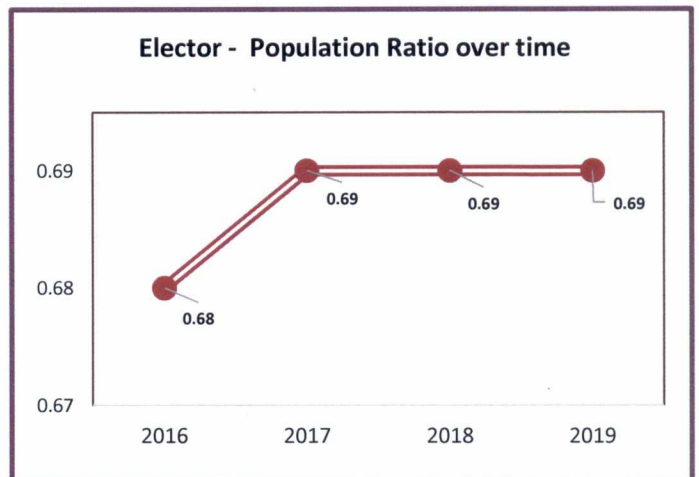
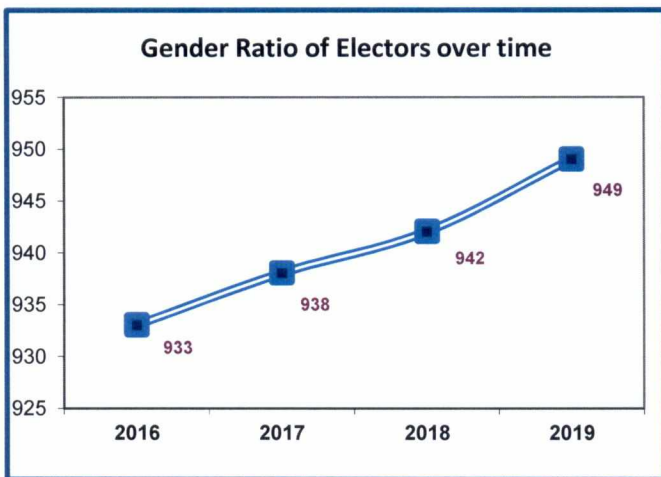

## **Continuous Updation Programme, 2019**

After Final Publication of Electoral Rolls, the period for Continuous Updation programme with reference to 01.01.2019 begins. Under Continuous Updation programme, citizens, who are otherwise eligible, may enroll their names in electoral rolls. Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal appeals to the electors of the State to verify their electoral status in the electoral rolls. An elector may check the details of assembly constituency, polling station, his part and serial number in the electoral roll by any of the following means:

- ✓ Call toll-free Help Line number 1950
- ✓ Type WB<>EC<>EPIC NO and send to 51969
- ✓ Access [www.ceowestbengal.nic.in](http://www.ceowestbengal.nic.in) and search your name in electoral rolls with Voter Card number
- ✓ Download **ANUBHAV** app from Google Play store and know electoral details

In order to facilitate citizens for enrolling their names into electoral rolls, BLOs will sit at respective Polling Stations on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and receive forms from the citizens. Citizens may file form 6 and form 8 for enrolment and correction in their electoral details.

## **National Voters' Day, 2019**

The National Voters' Day will be celebrated on 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 across the State. The State level NVD programme will be celebrated at Mohar Kunjo, Kolkata at 2:00 pm. In the districts, National Voters' Day will be celebrated at Polling Stations, Blocks, Sub-divisions and district headquarters. State level NVD Competition will be held on 18<sup>th</sup> January at Bhasa Bhavan among district winners of Quiz and Extempore Speech Competition. On the occasion of the Voters' Day, District Election Officers, Electoral Registration Officers and Booth Level Officers are going to be felicitated in recognition of their contribution for improvement in Gender Ratio, enrolment of young electors and cleansing of electoral rolls alongside making commendable contribution in the context of accessible electoral registration and community mobilization.
